hank you for reviewing the following consignment tips. By following them, you will find that consigning at the Woman's Exchange is a simple and easy process that is worthwhile and profitable for all.

NOTE: While we sometimes limit, or cannot accept some of your lower priced items, we almost always will accept all of your finer things. For example, we will accept all of your designer clothing, in excellent conditions, on every clothing consignment day. We will also accept all of your very expensive miscellaneous items on every miscellaneous consignment day. As always, when we are overstocked in a particular area, our telephone recording will inform our consignors. The Woman's Exchange gratefully accepts all donations of items which may not be consignable.

Before loading your car on consignment day, dial

364-3858 for message. It is our best source for letting you know what will not be accepted on any given day due to such situations as temporary overstock.

FURNITURE CONSIGNMENT

- A signed contract is required in order to consign. Contracts are available at the Business Office Monday through Friday between 9:00am-4pm
- We require photos of all furniture items. Photos can either be emailed to lploger @sarasotawex.com along with your phone number or quickest method is to bring them into the store Monday through Thursday between 9:30am 3:30pm.
- If you have small furniture items that

you can easily load into your vehicle Linda will gladly look at them for approval Monday thru Thursday 9:00am – 12:00pm. We ask that you call ahead to confirm that Linda is available to assist you.

- If your items are accepted for consignment you may check them in with Linda or we can provide pick-up at a nominal fee.
- Please make sure your consignment #
 is written on beigh masking tape and
 attached on top of the item in the upper
 right hand corner of the item.

GENERAL CONSIGNMENT

- Prior to arriving at the Woman's Exchange, it is important that you label each item with your account number using a ball point pen and a piece of beige masking tape that is approximately 1" long. This helps to ensure that your consignments are properly credited to your account. This means that every dish and every glass in every place setting needs to be labeled. Masking tape is preferred because it does not ruin an items surface. It is best to place the masking tape on the bottom of each item, taking care to avoid covering any manufacturer's mark or label that might provide valuable information to our appraisers and customers.
- A consignment slip must be filled out for each category of items being consigned (ex. linens, miscellaneous, ladies etc.) and be presented to the person accepting your items for consignment. Consignment slips are available during consignment hours and also online.
- Consigned items must be in excellent condition. Soiled, stained, chipped or cracked merchandise, will not be accepted for consignment but may be donated.
- Tableware, dishes and glasses, etc...
 will be accepted in serving sets of 6
 or more only. This does not apply to
 serving piece.
- Clothing MUST be in style and less than 3 years old (unless truly vintage or antique), of good quality

(no discount house brands) and be in wearable condition. Each item must be on our hangers and labeled with your account number placed in the neck or waistband of the garment, Again, please use masking tape and a ballpoint pen.

- Consignors are limited to no more than 10 pieces of costume jewelry per order.
- Appointments are recommended for better costume jewelry, fine jewelry (such as gold, diamonds, etc...) and fine art (paintings, sculptures and prints) as well as clothing.
- We can only accept 5 hardbound books per consignment order. Books must be mold and mildew free and labeled with your account number on the back cover.
- All linens must be labeled with your consignment number and with the size indicated. They must be good quality, odor free and not stained or faded.
- Battery operated items, such as watches or clocks, MUST have batteries installed and be in working order.

Note: Holiday Items EXPIRE THE DAY AFTER THE HOLIDAY. NO EXCEPTIONS!
