- **Required Documents in addition to application. Please do not use staples.**
 1. A Personal 300 word Essay outlining your educational goals, career aspirations and reasons why you consider yourself deserving of an Exchange Scholarship.
 2. Two (2) signed recommendations (one-page maximum) from a faculty member, instructor or mentor in your proposed field.
 3. One (1) proof of Sarasota/Manatee County permanent residency if you have not graduated from a local high school. (If you graduated from a local high school, provide the name of the school and the year of graduation.) Proof of residency may include: Florida driver license, Florida voter registration card or State approved ID (Note: Permanent residency does not include yearly school related housing.)
 4. Prior year's copy of IRS Form 1040 (Pages 1-2 only) of any parent, stepparent or guardian claiming you as a dependent with Social Security Numbers blackened out. All information is kept confidential. Failure to provide accurate and truthful information will be cause for disqualification.
 5. College transcript to be sent directly from your institution to The Exchange addressed as above.
- **The Board of Directors will notify you via email of its scholarship decision by April 30, 2019.**
